SUBJECT: Final Registration Report – Fall Quarter 2003

Attached are the official registration figures for Fall Quarter 2003 as reported to the Office of the President. This report reflects all registered students as of Wednesday, October 15, the fifteenth day of instruction. Total campus enrollment is 24,707, which is 1,159 students more than the Fall Quarter 2002.

The new undergraduate target was 5,300 (3,800 freshmen and 1,500 transfers). The registered freshmen total is 3,799 and the registered transfers total is 1,455. The total new undergraduates is 5,254, which is 46 fewer than our overall goal. The mean high school GPA of our registered freshmen is 3.96 with a 1245 total mean SAT score (598 Verbal and 647 Math).
